- As conference general chair, <u>launched WCNC 2022</u> conference held in Austin April 10-13, 2022. Positive financials, 832 in attendance (Hybrid), 11 Patrons (Bronze-Platinum), 9 Sponsors/Supporters, Exhibits & Showcase (Hybrid), Compelling Technical & Industry Programs, 71 Technical Sessions (361 published papers), 9 Keynote Speakers, 2 Executive Forums, Dialog with Industry Leaders, 12 Panel Sessions, 7 Industry Presentations, 12Ttutorials, 11 Workshops, Startup Competition, WIE, welcome reception, VIP/OC Dinner, and Conference Banquet,
- Working with Dallas Chapter in holding <u>1 day Student Conference</u> on April 10.
- Defined <u>advanced feature website</u> for NA that now offers list of current and planned meetings and lectures for anyone to participate, and a section to share news from all chapters about successes, announcements, opportunities..
- Defined <u>chapter vitality check</u> and Trello for tracking across NA on a quarterly basis. Austin will be a pilot chapter connecting to the Regional website.
- Working with the ComSoc, supporting initiatives such as mentoring program, Students/Industry, Preparation for GCCC at Globecom
