Section Nomination Process

Pikes Peak Section has an open nomination process. The Nomination Deadline is **26 September 2024 12:00 AM America/Denver**. You will be able to generate the 1st slate of candidates after the deadline. Nominees are listed on the table below. Document Status indicates if the nominee has a complete set of documents: Bio, Position Statement and willingness to serve. You may click on a nominee's name to view his/her volunteer history and additional info.

The Election Committee will select from all such submissions at least two but not more than three candidates for each position elected at-large, and submit the slate of candidates to the ExCom for ratification.

In the case where the slate that is submitted for ratification consists of a single candidate, the Section ExCom may recommend to the Region Director the approval of proceeding with the election process with a single candidate slate.

The slate of candidates for elected office shall be communicated to the voting members of the Section not less than six weeks prior to the election date. In addition, provision shall be made in the communication for petition candidates for these offices.

The entire slate of candidates for office shall be communicated to the voting members of the Section not less than two weeks prior to the election date.
